

The Second Year Tutorial Centre - MC 4067

“Students Helping Students”

In the Fall Term 2007, the second year Tutorial Centre will provide a tutorial service for the courses MATH 235, MATH 237 and MATH 239. The Tutorial Centre will be staffed by graduate students.

The Tutorial Centre has two main purposes:

- Tutors may be consulted about the course material
- Tutors may be consulted about the problem sets

If you consult one of the tutors, please take your course notes with you so that your problem may be efficiently handled. Furthermore, if you request assistance with a particular problem please take your rough work with you in order to aid the tutor in identifying your difficulty.

Please do not expect the tutors to solve the problems for you. Once you have been given a hint, you should work on your problem alone until you either complete it or need further assistance.

The Tutorial Centre will open on Monday September 17th. The hours will be posted outside MC 4067. Since Algebra (MATH 235) assignments are due on Wednesdays, and Calculus (MATH 237) and Combinatorics (MATH 239) assignments are due on Fridays, the schedule will look something like this:
